THE COURSE

The ride will be approximately 12 miles long, comprising of an eight mile ride across the Buckinghamshire countryside with a 4 mile cross country course (at the end) with a choice of 20 purely optional jumps each having easier and harder alternatives (ranging from 1ft – 4ft) and two purpose built water jumps; all of which can be easily avoided, without penalty, by those preferring to enjoy a ride in some beautiful countryside, without jumping.

SCORING

This is not a competition and it is envisaged that everyone should be able to complete the course. Scoring for sponsorship calculations will be simply based on the number of miles completed. Time does not count, but the course is normally completed within two hours.

SPONSORS

Riders must find their own sponsors and obtain from them the guarantee to pay the relevant amount. The total amount promised by the various sponsors must come to a minimum of **£10** for riders under 16 years of age on 16th May 2010 and **£15** for riders 16 years and over.

FIRST AID

On site qualified 4x4 paramedic crew will be on site all day in case of accidents and emergencies.

RULES

All riders must wear hard hats, crash helmets and current BETA approved back protectors. Horses and ponies must be over four years old before 16th May 2010. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

On receipt of entry forms, competitors will be allocated a starting time and be notified of this time.

Requests to ride together will be noted accordingly. Please note that group rides should have more than 8 riders per allotted times. Preferred starting times will be arranged whenever possible but cannot be guaranteed.

Only three attempts are allowed at any jump. Passing is allowed.

Equetech, Cancer Research UK, The Organising Committee, The Land Owners, all persons and all organisations involved in the Ride disclaim all liability for any damage to any persons or property, howsoever caused, whether by negligence or otherwise. It is up to participants and spectators to make their own insurance arrangements. The decision of the Committee on any matter is final.

Failure to carry out instructions from a steward may lead to disqualification.

ENTRIES

Each rider pays a non-returnable entry fee of **£15** which must be enclosed with the entry form, together with an A5 (or A4 if more than 4 riders) stamped addressed envelope for starting times and sponsorship forms. Cheques should be made payable to **Equetech – Canter for a Cure**. Requests to ride together must be made with entry forms.

Entries close **Thursday 13th May 2010**. Late entries will incur a 50% surcharge.

It is a condition of entry that sponsorship money is paid on the day prior to starting the ride.
